

Train stop Malmö-Lund August 28 - September 6

Replacement buses will operate the route. Expect longer travel time.

Between August 28 and September 6, train traffic between Malmö and Lund will be stopped. Plan for the stop and expect longer travel time.

Keep in mind:

Some Pågatåg trains will stop at the stations Burlöv, Åkarp and Hjärup. Hjärup is the turning point. Replacement buses runs between Malmö and Lund and between Hjärup and Lund.

It may be more traffic on the roads as many will commute by car. Avoid travel during the train stop, or during rush hours. Then you won't be affected by the train stop, and you will make it easier for those who have to travel.

Up-to-date travel information during the stop can be found in Skånetrafiken's app or in the train companies' sites.

Why is the railway closed?

Between August 28 and September 6, two new railway bridges will be launched into the embankment at the upcoming station in Klostergården.

During the work, railway traffic between Malmö and Lund will be stopped.

Four tracks Malmö-Lund

Trafikverket is upgrading the railway between Malmö and Lund, from two tracks to four. This increases the capacity, reduces the risk of disturbances and improves the environment.
